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COVID-19 Press Briefing May 11, 2021 / 4:00 p.m.

* Beginning the week of May 10th, Electronic Press Briefings will only be sent out biweekly on Tuesday's and Friday's at 4:00 p.m. The narrative and charts of the new cases will include the previous days. We will only report the numbers that are directly received to our departments. ZOOM briefings will be scheduled on an as needed basis and ZOOM invites will be sent out. SITUATIONAL UPDATE: STAY HOME; WASH HANDS; SOCIAL DISTANCING; WEAR A FACE COVERING!

- Data Update New data format: We will be reporting the total number of positive cases, ages, number of active cases / mandatory isolation and on Friday's we will include the NYS Fatality Data. We will no longer be reporting by region, facility data, negative and recovered numbers. Hospitalizations and ages of new positive individuals will be reported in the narrative. The total age breakdown and potential community exposure risks will continue to be posted on our websites. The data reporting chart will also include the Finger Lakes COVID Vaccination Hub updates on vaccination in both total number and percentage.
- Genesee County reporting 32 new positive cases of COVID-19 for a total of 5193 positive cases (covering 05/07-05/11).
 - The individuals are in their 0-19's, 20's, 30's, 40's, and 50's.
 - 5 of the current positive individuals are hospitalized.
- Orleans County reporting 37 new positive cases of COVID-19 for a total of 3007 positive cases (covering 05/07-05/11).
 - The individuals are in their 0-19's, 20's, 30's, 40's, 50's and 60's.
 - 0 of the current positive individuals are hospitalized.

Vaccine Update: Both counties are offering vaccination clinic registration via phone – these numbers are for COVID Vaccination Registration ONLY. In Genesee call (585) 815-7168. In Orleans call (585) 589-3170. For both numbers ask for the vaccine registration help line. The vaccine registration help line is NOT associated with either Public Health Department. The individuals who answer the phone can ONLY assist with registering for a COVID-19 clinic, they cannot answer COVID-related questions. For more information about the vaccine and access for those who are 60 and older who do NOT have internet access, please contact your respective Office for the Aging (OFA). For Genesee OFA please call 585-813-2457 for COVID-19 Vaccine assistance between 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. and leave a message if you get voicemail and someone will return the call. For Orleans OFA please call 585-589-3191 between 9:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. and leave a message if you get voicemail and someone will return the call. The OFA offices can only assist with the clinic links as they are available. The system may experience slowdowns and crashing due to high volume. Please be patient and try again later.

Social distancing, wearing cloth masks/face coverings over the mouth and nose, and handwashing, cleaning and disinfection protocol requirements are to be continued to limit the spread of COVID-19.

COVID-19 Reminders: If a person is identified as a contact, they will be notified by the County Health Department, quarantined and if warranted, swabbed if indicated. Limited information is provided to the public in compliance with **HIPAA regulations and out of the respect of those impacted by this virus**.

- When, and if, there is a situation where potential contact is made in a public location where contact tracing doesn't have actual names of close contacts, we will post an announcement on our websites to help seek contacts.
- If you are experiencing ANY COVID-19 related symptoms STAY HOME! Do not go to work, do not go to the store, do not go anywhere, YOU are spreading the virus. STAY HOME!
- ➤ Flu Season: It is important to get your flu shots now to build up immunity. It generally takes 2 weeks before immunity is built up after getting the shot. Once you have the flu vaccine, if you do get the flu, research shows that the vaccination reduces the risk of severe illness. Getting a flu vaccine can save healthcare resources for the care of patients with COVID-19 and other illnesses. - ➤ Flu Tracking: For the 2020-2021 Flu Season we will provide data weekly on the current influenza activity. To check the data click here. For the current week ending date 05/01/21 Genesee County has 0 case and Orleans County has 0 cases. There are 90 cases statewide. This is -14% from the previous week. Cases (Statewide) Season to date: 4,681. This data is influenza that is confirmed by laboratory testing. Not everyone seeks testing for confirmation of the flu.
